underdog horned frogs win against oklahoma sooners

The match up between the Horned Frogs and the Oklahoma University Sooners was a turning point in TCU's whirlwind football season. Up against the #18 team in the nation, the Frogs had their work cut out for them. Thanks to the combination of smart plays on both the offensive and defensive fronts, the Frogs were able to defy the odds and obtain a 55-24 victory over the Sooners. This victory marked the first time the Frogs had been 4-0 since 2017. The Horned Frogs totaled 668 yards of offense, with 479 of those yards occurring in the first half. QB Max Duggan was the standout star of the game, totaling 418 yards of offense, completing 23 of the 33 passes for 302 yards, and adding 116 yards rushing on just five carries. Kendre Miller (right) also stood out to fans, especially as he made a 69-yard touchdown rush near the end of the game. Emari Demeardo (left) assisted in the decisive victory making TCU the sole undefeated college football team in Texas. Smashing attendance records and expectations, the TCU v.
