if He were dead or alive

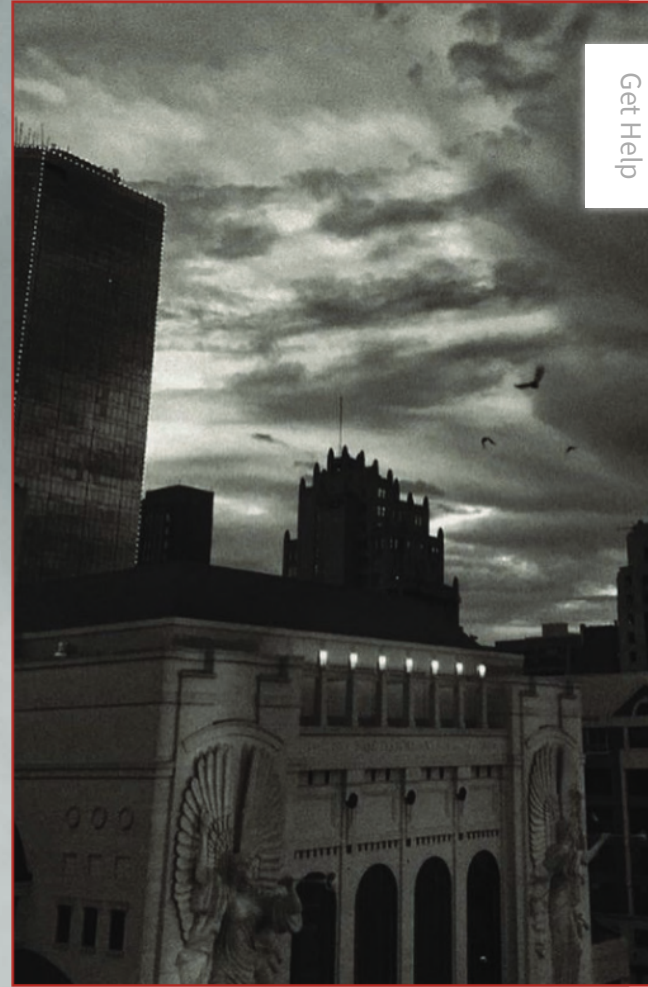
until you look inside?



Schrodinger's God

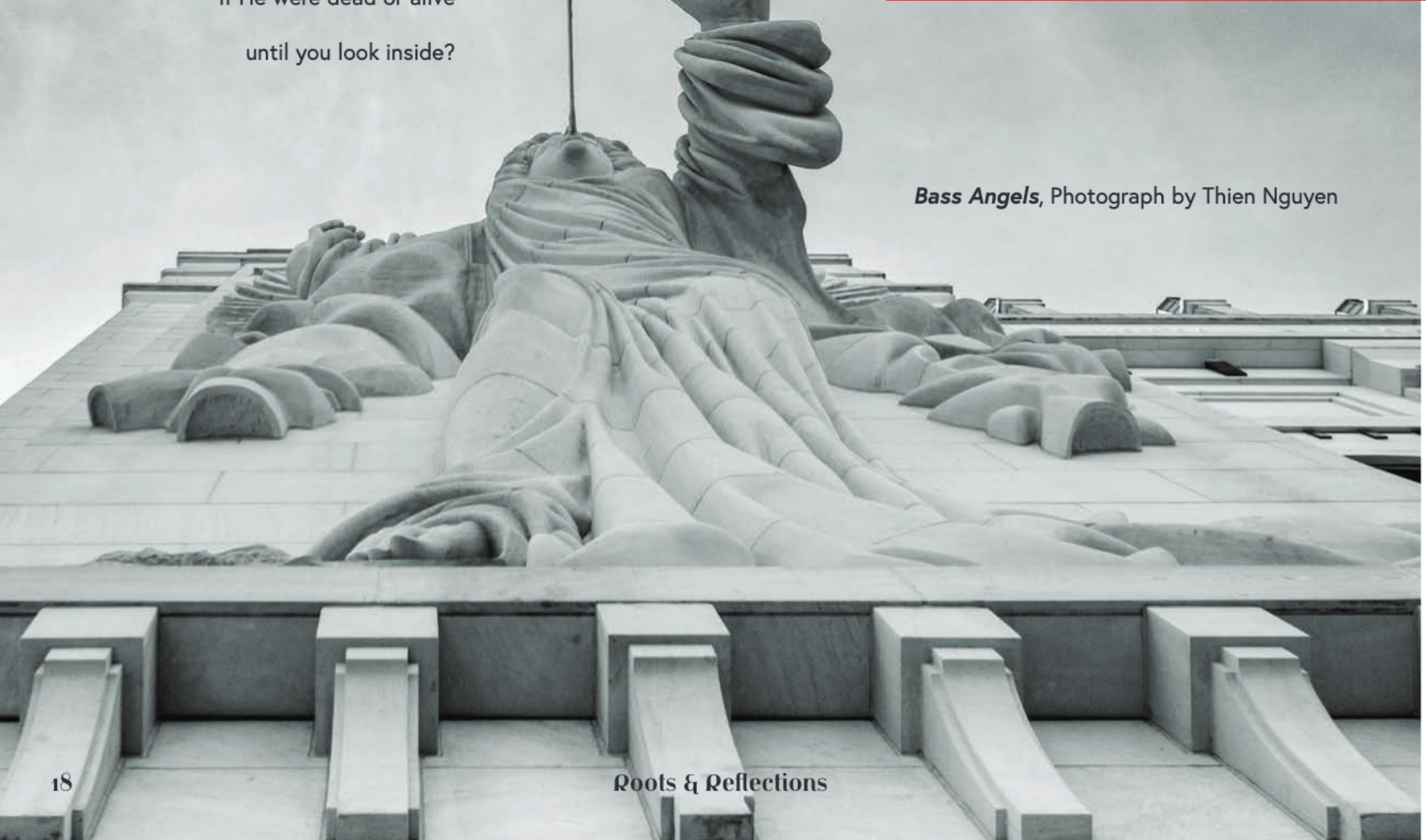
